### 9 Rocco's Electric

This new bar and restaurant in the space that previously housed Spanish tapas spot Tinto at the Saguaro Hotel puts a lot of emphasis on fresh cocktails. And that's underscored by the fact there's a staff chef dedicated in part to concocting the housemade syrups used in the drinks. There's a honey version for the Bee's Knees, orgeat for the Mai Tais and Demerara syrup used in the Rum Old-Fashioned. Beer drinkers can go for the rotating lager, sour, or porter and the bartenders plan to offer some tap cocktails soon. There's also a Mexican-ish menu of sopes, salads, and an array of appetizers.
