

Saguaro Palm Springs is ready for your wedding

The Saguaro hotel in Palm Springs has taken a stronger step toward attracting weddings and other types of group meetings with its newly renovated ballrooms.

The second floor Sago and Agave ballrooms, with a combined 5,729 square feet have been renovated with new flooring, lighting and other improvements. The Sago also has a new 1,175-square-foot terrace with a sweeping view of the hotels' lawn and pool area. The terrace is still under construction, and will be complete by the end of the month.

"We are seeing substantial traction with bookings of this new event space," remarked Matt Shough, general manager for the Saguaro. "Guests and clients are really seeing our vision of a revitalized indoor and outdoor event space."

Expanding the Sago room with outdoor space makes it both more flexible and more desirable, said Shough.

"A major attraction to Palm Springs is embracing our gorgeous natural surroundings," he explained. "By bringing these inside as well as revitalizing the interior we feel this space will be utilized to its true potential."
